

## Neilreichia: Guidelines for Reviewers

The maximum period of time between manuscript submission and final decision should not exceed 6 months.

The standard reviewing time is 30 days. It can be extended to up to 60 days after further inquiry.

Authors are advised to have their manuscripts, if not written in their mother tongue, checked by a native speaker before submission. Manuscripts that don't meet linguistic standards or do not follow the guidelines and style of the journal (e.g., concerning the correct citation of references) will be rejected without review, but may be resubmitted at a later point. Reviewers are not expected to make such corrections, as this is the responsibility of the authors, but useful hints are welcome.

Authors will receive from the editors the reviewed manuscripts along with the evaluation form and one of the following specifications:

- Accepted
- Minor revision
- Major revision
- Rejected

Manuscripts submitted for review and publication to the journal **Neilreichia** (except the floristic data compilation "New floristic records from Austria" edited by series editors, book reviews, tributes and obituaries) undergo single-blind reviews by at least two reviewers. In some cases (e.g., manuscripts with fewer than 6 pages, i.e. short communications), one reviewer may be sufficient. If desired by the reviewer, their name can be acknowledged in the imprint on p. 2 without indicating which manuscript they were reviewing. The default reviewing process, however, is anonymous. The final decision on any manuscript is made exclusively by the Editors.
